THE LAND CONTROL ACT

(Cap. 302)

EXEMPTION

THE TRADE DISPUTES ACT

(Cap. 234)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 2 of the Trade Disputes (Levies and Subscriptions other than Trade Union Dues) Regulations, the Minister for Labour makes the following Order:—

THE COLLECTION OF SUBSCRIPTIONS (KENYA NATIONAL UNION OF TEACHERS) (BUSIA BRANCH) ORDER, 1981

1. This Order may be cited as the Collection of Subscriptions (Kenya National Union of Teachers) (Busia Branch) Order, 1981.
2. The Kenya National Union of Teachers (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") is authorized to collect subscriptions (other than trade union dues) from its members who belong to the Busia Branch for the approved purpose of financing the construction of a building to be used by the Union in Busia Township.
3. Every employer who employs at least ten members of the Busia Branch of the Union and upon whom a notice in writing shall have been served by the General Secretary of the Union pursuant to regula-

tion 6 of the Trade Disputes (Leviés and Subscriptions other than Trade Union Dues) Regulations is required to deduct from the wages of each of his employees who is named in that notice and who is, and who in the notice acknowledges that he is, a member of the Busia Branch of the Union, the monthly sum of fifty shillings for a period of eighteen consecutive months and to make payment of the total sum so collected into the Union's account with the Standard Bank Limited, Busia Branch, P.O. Box 88, Busia.
