RULING ON REVISION

This matter was brought to my attention pursuant to the provisions of sections 362 and 364 (1) of the criminal procedure code. The issue at stake is that the Public Health Officer has obtained orders of eviction against 7 tenants occupying premises situated in L.R. No. BUNGOMA MUNICIPALITY/1368. via Bungoma S.P.M's Misc. Criminal Application No. 4 of 2005. In fact the tenants have been given notices to vacate.
