**A BILL ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EVICTION OF
TENANTS (CONTROL) ORDINANCE, 1949**

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Eviction of Tenants (Control) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read and construed as one with the Eviction of Tenants (Control) Ordinance 1949 hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

Short title

No 12 of 1949

2 There shall be substituted for section 4 of the principal Ordinance the following new section—

Repeal and replacement of section 4 of the principal Ordinance

4 (1) The Board shall not give such consent except—

Grounds of consent

(a) on the grounds of hardship, or

(b) in the case of a consent required under sub-section (1) of the last preceding section, on the grounds that a notice in writing by the Mombasa Municipal Board to the effect that a house is either structurally dangerous or dangerous to public health has been served on the owner or tenant not less than four weeks before such consent is given, or

(c) in the case of a consent required under sub-section (1) of the last preceding section, on the grounds that a notice in writing by the landowner to the effect that the landowner requires the land upon which a house is situated for the purpose of developing the same in accordance with a plan already approved by the Mombasa Municipal Board has been served on the owner or tenant not less than three months before such consent is given, or

(d) in the case of a consent required under sub-section (2) of the last preceding section, on the grounds that the rates payable in respect of the land have been increased

(2) The decision of the Board to give or withhold consent shall be final and shall not be called in question in any court

3. There shall be substituted for section 5 of the principal Ordinance the following new section—

Repeal and replacement of section 5 of the principal Ordinance

40 Penalty

5 Every person who—

(a) contravenes any provision of section 3 of this Ordinance, or

(b) makes any false statement to the Board, or

(c) being a landowner, and having obtained vacant possession of a house and the land therewith by reason of the provisions of paragraph (c) of sub-section (1) of section 4 of this Ordinance, fails within a period 5 of two months from the date upon which the house and land were vacated, to begin or cause to be begun works for the purpose of developing the area in accordance with the plan already approved by 10 the Mombasa Municipal Board, or

(d) being a landowner, and having obtained vacant possession of a house and the land therewith by reason of the provisions of paragraph (c) of sub-section (1) of section 15 4 of this Ordinance, and having begun works for the purpose of developing the area in accordance with the plan already approved by the Mombasa Municipal Board, without good cause either fails to 20 continue or delays the completion of such works,

shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a term which may extend to 25 twelve months or to both such fine and imprisonment

Provided that no proceedings shall be instituted against any landowner under paragraphs (c) and (d) of this section until the consent, in writing, of the 30 Attorney General has first been obtained

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to make certain amendments to the Eviction of Tenants (Control) Ordinance, 1949

Under that Ordinance, no action can be taken to evict a tenant occupying a house in any of the areas scheduled in the Ordinance, without the consent of the Rent Control Board for the Coast Province, and the grounds upon which such a consent may be given are limited by the Ordinance

It is not desirable that this Ordinance should stand in the way of slum clearance and the progressive development of the scheduled area. *Clause 2* of the Bill replaces section 4 of the Ordinance, in order that the Rent Control Board may give its consent to the eviction of a tenant where the house is dangerous or the development of the scheduled area would otherwise be delayed

Clause 3 of the Bill replaces section 5 of the Ordinance, and it is now made an offence for a landowner who, having obtained vacant possession of a house fails to take the necessary steps to develop the property

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if this Bill is enacted

**A BILL ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LAND
ACQUISITION (MOMBASA OIL REFINERY)
ORDINANCE, 1953**

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Mombasa Oil Refinery) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955 Short title

2. The proviso to sub-section (3) of section 8 of the Land Acquisition (Mombasa Oil Refinery) Ordinance, 1953, (in this Ordinance referred to as the principal Ordinance), is amended by substituting for paragraph (i) and for sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (ii) thereof the following paragraph and sub-paragraph respectively— Amendment of section 8 (3) of the principal Ordinance No 35 of 1953

“(i) the draft of every such declaration shall be laid before the Legislative Council and shall be approved by resolution of the Legislative Council before the same is submitted to the Governor and, if the Legislative Council resolves that the draft be not so submitted, no further proceedings shall be taken thereon, but without prejudice to the laying before the Legislative Council of a new draft,”

“(a) the appointed day for the purposes of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be the date of such declaration as aforesaid, and”

3. There shall be substituted for sub-section (4) of section 9 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section— Replacement of section 9 (4) of the principal Ordinance

“(4) The draft of every order made under this section shall be laid before the Legislative Council and shall be approved by resolution of the Legislative Council before the same is submitted to the Governor and, if the Legislative Council resolves that the draft be not so submitted, no further proceedings shall be taken thereon, but without prejudice to the laying before the Legislative Council of a new draft, and every order made under this section shall come into effect on the date of such order ”

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The First Schedule to the Land Acquisition (Mombasa Oil Refinery) Ordinance, 1953, contains a list of “Scheduled Lands” which vested in the Crown when that Ordinance came into force on 1st December, 1954. Section 8 of the Ordinance enables the Governor, at any time before the expiration of ten years from the coming into operation of the Ordinance, to declare any other lands within the Mombasa or Kwale districts to be Scheduled Lands. Section 8 (3), however, requires that where such other lands are not unalienated Crown lands at the date of any declaration, then such declaration shall be laid before the Legislative Council on the first day of the meeting of the Council after the date of the making of the declaration and unless before the conclusion of that meeting the Legislative Council resolves that the declaration shall not be approved, it comes into effect on the day following the conclusion of the meeting, or if during the meeting the Legislative Council approves the declaration with modifications, it comes into effect, as modified, on the day of such approval. Section 2 of the Ordinance defines “meeting” in relation to the Legislative Council as having the same meaning as it has in the Standing Orders of the Legislative Council, and the word accordingly means “the sittings of the Council commencing at the beginning of a session or when summoned after having been adjourned and

terminating when the Council is adjourned *sine die* or at the conclusion of a session' The result of these provisions is that if a meeting of the Legislative Council is in progress at the time when it is desired to make a declaration under section 8 to which sub-section (3) applies, it is not possible to lay that declaration before the Legislative Council until the next meeting of the Council and the declaration cannot come into effect until the end of that meeting. Similar provisions in respect of orders made under section 9 of the Ordinance result in the same difficulties.

The effect of these provisions is to impose a possibly considerable delay upon the acquisition of land necessary for the development of the oil refinery, which at the best will cause inconvenience and might have more serious and expensive results.

It is, therefore, considered that these provisions should be amended to provide that the draft of every declaration under section 8 (3) and of every order under section 9 should be laid before Legislative Council and approved by positive resolution before it is made and that, when so made, such declarations and orders shall have effect upon the date on which they are made. This procedure increases rather than decreases the control of the Legislative Council since it ensures that each proposed declaration or order shall have the positive approval of the Legislature.

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if this Bill is enacted.
