GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTANCY EXAMINATIONS

THE Kenya Government Accountancy Examinations Nos. 1 and 2, for this year, as set out in Personnel Circular No. 32 of 10th November 1966, will be held on the 16th and 17th December 1970, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:—

2. Responsibility

The Government Accountancy Examinations are the responsibility of Public Service Commission, whose decision on all related matters shall be final.

3. Scheme of Examinations

Each examination will consist of three papers, held over two days as follows:—

First Day

(a) Book-keeping and Accounts .. (3 hours) 0900-1200 (b) Public Finance (3 hours) 1330-1630

Second Day

(c) Government Accounts (3 hours) 0900-1200

4. Syllabuses

The syllabuses of the examinations are set out in Part III of the Appendix to Personnel Circular No. 32.

5 Fligibility to Enter

The examination will be open to civil servants who must be Kenya citizens serving with the Government of Kenya, and in the case of:—

- (a) Examination No. 1 be serving clerical officers who have had not less than one year's practical accounting experience immediately prior to the examination; and
- (b) Examination No. 2 be either-
 - (i) in the grade of G.5 at the date of introduction of the scheme (and thereby exempt from Examination No. 1); or
 - (ii) any other officer having successfully completed a three months Junior Accounts Course either at Kenya Institute of Administration or Government Training Institute, Maseno; or
 - (iii) passed the Government Accounts Examination No. 1.

Candidates must pass Examination No. 1 or have been exempted before offering themselves for Examination No. 2.

6. Entry Fees

Candidates for Examination No. 1 will be required to pay an entry fee of Sh. 10 and for No. 2 an entry fee of Sh. 20 and in no circumstances will these fees be refundable.

7. Entries

Candidates are required to complete in quadruplicate entry forms, which may be obtained from each Ministry/Department. Entries should be submitted through the Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments to the Examinations Officer of the Ministry of Education, and must be accompanied by a remittance covering the fees. Money/Postal Orders should be crossed and made payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, and should be sent, together with the entry forms, direct to the Examinations Officer. The closing date for all entries will be 30th September 1970, and in no circumstances will late entries be accepted. Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments are requested to ensure that entry forms are properly completed and are transmitted in good time.

8. Examination Centres

The examinations will be held in Nairobi, Mombasa, Nyeri, Kisumu, Nakuru, Embu, Kakamega and Garissa, and candidates must specify at which centre they propose to sit, and which will normally be that nearest to their station. The actual venue in each Provincial Centre will be notified to candidates in due course.

9. Conditions for Obtaining a Pass

In order to obtain a pass in the appropriate full examination, a candidate must pass every paper at one and the same sitting. The names of successful candidates will be published in the Kenya Gazette.

10. Effect of Passing

Once a candidate has passed one of these examinations, he will be eligible to be considered by the Public Service Commission for promotion to the next higher grade as and when vacancies occur, and in accordance with the provisions of the Scheme of Service as set out in Personnel Circular No. 32 of 1966.

11. Conduct of Examinations

Candidates will not be permitted to consult any books, files, notes, etc., during the examination, and any infringement of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the examination and such disqualification may also result in disciplinary action. Arrangements for the issue of examination papers, invigilation and submission of completed scripts, etc., will be as laid down by the Ministry of Education acting on the directions of the Public Service Commission of Kenya.

The examination will be open to civil servants who must be Kenya citizens serving with the Government of Kenya; and in

- (a) Examination No. 1 be serving Clerical, Higher or Senior Clerical Officers serving in Personnel Branches; or in the case of
- (b) Examination No. 2 be either-
 - (i) Personnel Officers Grade III; or
 - (ii) Personnel Officers Grade II (those Graduates who were appointed directly as Personnel Officers Grade II)


